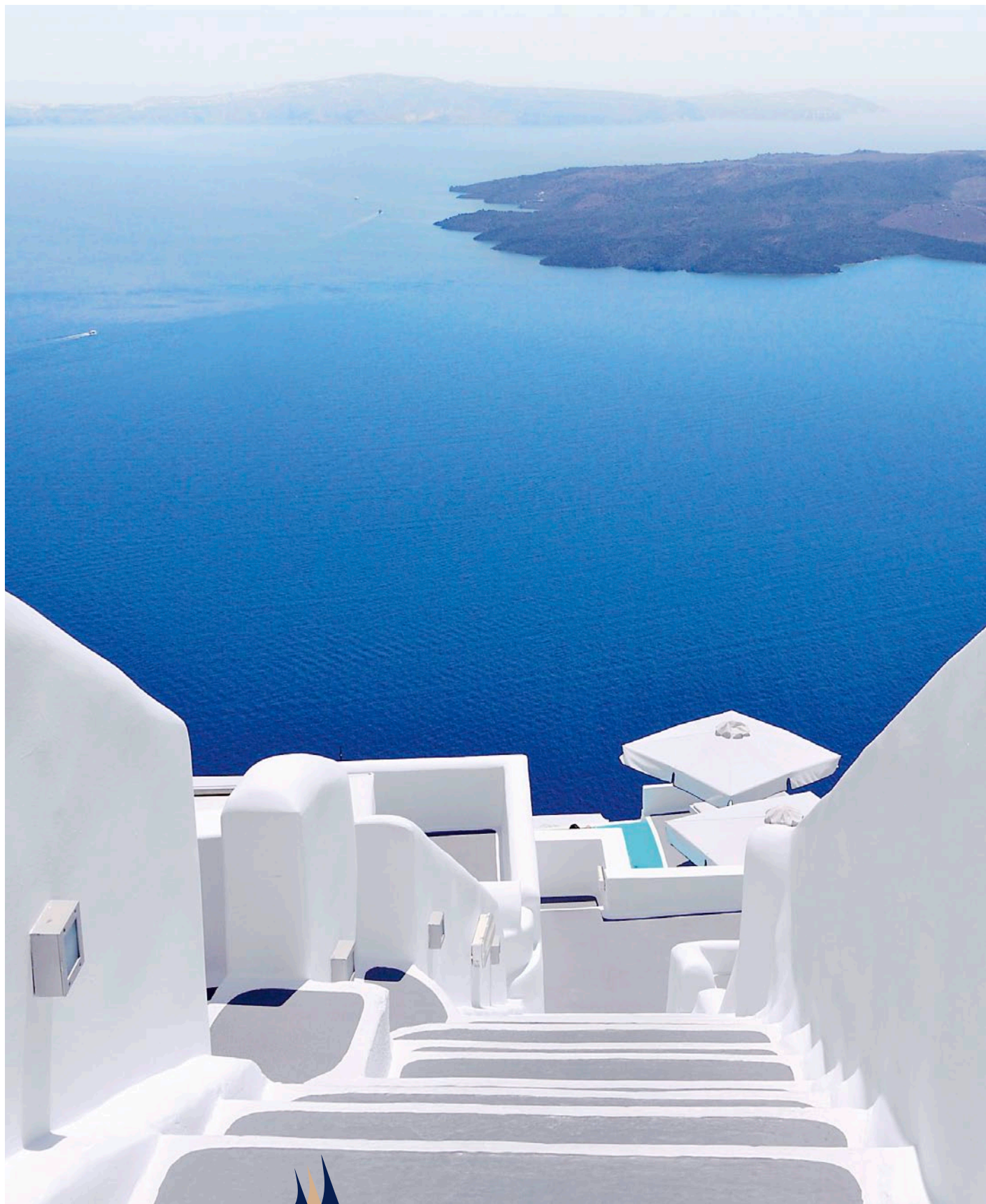

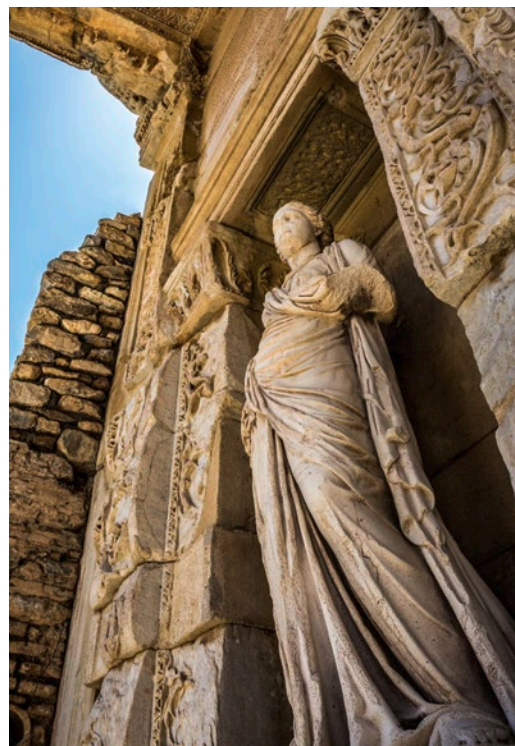


## ENCHANTED BY HISTORY: ISLANDS OF MYTH AND LEGEND

#### Day 1 Istanbul/Turkey

Disembarkation and start of the city tour. In the morning you will discover classical Istanbul with its imposing buildings, such as the Blue Mosque, the Saint Sophia Mosque, Hippodrome Square and the underground Byzantine Cistern. You will then board a private yacht (shared with German speaking post-cruise program guests). During a trip on the Bosphorus, the Turkish metropolis presents itself to you from a very special perspective. The strait, which is only around 700 m wide at its narrowest point, not only separates the city, but also two continents and forms a wonderful backdrop, with its glistening water, busy shipping traffic and spectacular Bosphorus bridges. Lunch on the way in a waterside restaurant. The tour ends at the Four Seasons Hotel Istanbul at the Bosphorus. Check-in and move into your room. The evening is at leisure. Overnight stay.



#### Day 2 Istanbul/Turkey

Breakfast at hotel. Today's full-day tour takes you across the Bosphorus Bridge to Istanbul's Asian side. You will first visit the Sakirin Mosque before immersing yourself in the life of Kadıköy, where tradition meets modernity. Here you stroll through the market and enjoy a typical Turkish lunch. Take the public ferry back to the European side to visit the Grand Bazaar of Istanbul, whose gigantic dimensions resemble a labyrinth. Afterwards return to the hotel. The evening is at leisure. Overnight stay.

#### Day 3 Istanbul/Turkey

Breakfast at the hotel. Check-out. Individual transfer to the airport. Transfer is not included but can be arranged upon request at an additional cost.
